

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**Between**  
**Recruiting and Retention College**  
**Fort Knox, Kentucky**  
**And**  
**Post University, Connecticut**

**1. Purpose of Articulation Agreement.** This agreement establishes the terms for the awarding of course credit from Post University for enlisted and commissioned personnel attending the Recruiting and Retention College (RRC). The applicable courses and associated credit are identified in Annex's (proposals).

**2. Background.** In support of HQDA EXORD 214-15 Post University has proposed their: Certificate of Human Resource Management; Associate of Science Management; Bachelor of Science Business Administration with Management Concentration; Bachelor of Science Management with Project Management Concentration; Bachelor of Science Business Administration with Marketing Concentration; Bachelors of Science Human Resource Management; Bachelors of Science Sports Management; and Bachelors of Science Management with Supply Chain Logistics Concentration for selection by CMF 79 soldiers and graduates of the Army Recruiting Course.

**4. Program.**

a. Registration. Soldier participation is voluntary. Soldiers who wish to benefit from this agreement will have two weeks from the start of the applicable course to register with and pay any associated fees to Post University.


b. Funding. Post University will ensure participating Soldiers are aware of all fees and charges before they register. Soldiers who participate are personally responsible for paying all costs associated with their participation. This agreement does


not establish any additional programs wherein the Army, relevant installation, or Army University will fund a Soldier's participation. Soldiers who participate are responsible for determining their eligibility for Tuition Assistance or other official educational benefits.


c. Course Credit and Degree Plans. This program is designed to assist participating Soldiers with obtaining a degree from Post University by obtaining academic credit for their military education and experience. This program includes the following degree programs: Certificate of Human Resource Management; Associate of Science Management; Bachelor of Science Business Administration with Management Concentration; Bachelor of Science Management with Project Management Concentration; Bachelor of Science Business Administration with Marketing Concentration; Bachelors of Science Human Resource Management; Bachelors of Science Sports Management; and Bachelors of Science Management, with Supply Chain Logistics Concentration. To obtain a degree, participating Soldiers must complete all additional general education courses, elective courses, and core courses required for the degree. Annex's (proposals) identify the available degree programs and the amount of credit that can be earned toward it from each noncommissioned and commissioned officer professional course.


d. Program Commitment. Post University commits to providing eligible Soldiers the credit as outlined in Annex's (proposal). Once a Soldier enrolls, the number and type of credit outlined in Annex at the time of enrollment will not change to the detriment of the Soldier. Once the Soldier pays all associated costs, the appropriate credit will be added to the Soldier's official Post University transcript. Recruiting and Retention College commits to advertising this agreement at appropriate Education Centers and other locations as well as on appropriate websites as permitted by Army regulations and policy.

5. Effective Date and Termination. This agreement will be effective from the date signed by the Commandant of Recruiting and Retention College and representative of Post University and will have a duration of three years. Upon expiration, this Agreement will be subject to renewal. Additions and changes to this Agreement may be made at any time with written agreement of both RRC and Post University. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon 60 days written notice to the other party via U.S. Certified mail. Termination must be in writing and signed by the approving officials or their designated representatives.
