ACADEMIC ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE U.S. ARMY GARRISON FORT LEONARD WOOD (USAGFLW) AND

THE U.S. ARMY MANEUVER SUPPORT CENTER OF EXCELLENCE (MSCoE), U.S. ARMY CHEMICAL, BIOLOGICAL, RADIOLOGICAL AND NUCLEAR SCHOOL (USACBRNS)

AND POST UNIVERSITY FOR

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY Agreement #AAA-W90GZM-18-006

- 1. Purpose of Articulation of Agreement. This Agreement establishes the terms for the awarding of course credit from Post University for enlisted personnel who has attended the United States Army Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear School (USACBRNS) enlisted professional military education. The applicable courses and associated credit are identified in Annex A.
- 2. **Background**. Human Resources Command (HRC)-Army Continuing Education Division (ACED) in October of 2017 released a "request for programs" (RFP). This RFP went to all schools on the GoArmyEd (GAE) website to propose their associates and bachelor degree programs toward Emergency Management, Environment Management Safety (OHSA) and Disaster Management for selection by a board based on developed criteria. Post University was selected to be one of the programs best suited for USACBRNS Soldiers.

4. Program.

- a. <u>Registration</u>. Soldier participation is voluntary. Soldiers who wish to benefit from this agreement will have one week prior to the start of the applicable course to register with and arrange payment for the course with Post University. Post University agrees to waive all associated course fees.
- b. <u>Funding</u>. Post University will ensure participating Soldiers are aware of all fees and charges before they register. Soldiers who participate are personally responsible for paying all costs associated with their participation. This agreement does not establish any additional programs wherein the Army or USACBRNS will fund a Soldier's participation. Soldiers who participate are responsible for determining their eligibility for Tuition Assistance or other official educational benefits.
- c. Course Credit and Degree Plans. This program is designed to assist participating Soldiers with obtaining a degree from Post University by obtaining academic credit from their military education and experience. This program includes the following degree program: Bachelor of Science Emergency Management and Homeland Security. To obtain a degree, participating Soldiers must complete all additional general education courses, elective courses, and core courses required for the degree. Annex A identifies the available degree programs and the amount of credit that can be earned toward it from each noncommissioned officer and professional military education course.
- d. <u>Program Commitment</u>. Post University commits to providing eligible Soldiers the credit as outlined in Annex A. Once a Soldier enrolls, the number and type of credit outlined in Annex A at the time of enrollment will not change to the detriment of the Soldier. Once the Soldier pays all associated costs, the appropriate credit will be added to the Soldier's official Post University transcript.
- 5. Effective Date and Termination. This Agreement takes effect beginning on the day after the last Party signs. The Agreement expires on 30 September 2021. It will be reviewed annually in its entirety. This Agreement may be modified by the written agreement of the Parties, duly signed by their authorized representatives. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party by giving at least 60 days written notice to
