The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act is a federal law protecting the confidentiality of student records. It restricts others from accessing or discussing your education records without your consent.

Except as otherwise permitted by Law, Post University will not disclose any personally identifiable information contained in your files without your signed and written consent. One exception permits Post University to disclose your “directory information” to anyone within the Post University community and to the general public.
