## THE EXTRAS

- ❖ Curtains
- ❖ Posters/pictures
- ❖ Microwave
- ❖ Mini-refrigerator (no larger than 3.5 cubic feet)
- ❖ Iron & ironing board
- ❖ TV/DVD player/gaming system
- ❖ Small stereo
- ❖ Fan
- ❖ Rug
- ❖ Dry erase board
- ❖ Computer/laptop & printer
- ❖ Power strips with a built-in fuse/surge protector ONLY (UL approved)
- ❖ Non-halogen lights

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

- ❖ Air conditioners/space heaters/immersion heaters
- ❖ Candles/incense
- ❖ Extension cords
- ❖ Pets (small fish in aquariums 10 gallons or less are permitted)
- ❖ Open coil appliances (toasters, hot plates, etc.)
- ❖ Stoves, fryers, or propane-based grills and non-UL approved appliances
- ❖ Weapons of any kind
- ❖ Dart boards
- ❖ Hover boards
- ❖ Drones
