Participating Graduates

Graduates walking in commencement should check-in beginning 2 hours before their ceremony at Post University / Downtown, 140 Bank Street, Waterbury, Connecticut. This check-in and line-up area is around the corner from The Palace Theater. Graduates and faculty will process as a group to the venue with much pageantry!

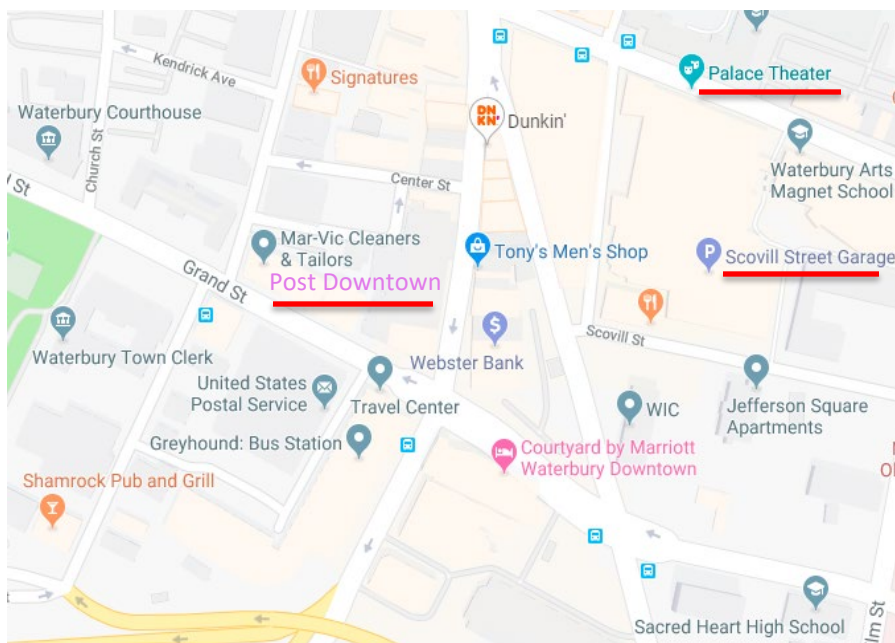
(In the event of heavy rain, graduates will be asked to check-in at The Palace Theater stage door entrance, located on Brook St.)

Guests

Guests of graduates walking in commencement should arrive at The Palace Theater, 100 E. Main Street Waterbury, beginning one hour before their ceremony. All guests must have a ticket to enter the theater. There will be no exceptions.

Seating is assigned and guests must use the main theater entrance only. Guests arriving after the start of the processional will be asked to wait in the lobby until the processional is complete, and will then be seated.

Parking for students and guests is free at the Scovill Street Garage, 33 Scovill Street. Post University Associates will be positioned at key locations downtown, to guide guests as needed!
