



Dear Post University Parents and Students,

Post University's Board of Trustees recently approved the college's comprehensive fee schedule for the 2023-24 academic year. The annual tuition price will increase from \$28,250 to \$31,075. Please note unlike any of our peers, Post has not implemented a price increase in seven years, and during that time, we have made significant investments in programming, facilities, and the student experience to ensure an extraordinary and personal experience for our students. During the COVID-19 years, we dramatically *lowered* the tuition because we felt it was the right thing to do as all families were challenged socially, mentally, and economically. Since then, we have also taken significant measures to control costs but given the inflationary environment, we felt the increase was essential.

While this increase will not completely offset the rising costs of the University's operations, we are committed to remaining an extraordinary value among private colleges and universities in Connecticut. I am mindful that our students and families are affected by our increase, coupled with the overall macroeconomic pressures we all face today. It was in this spirit that we tried to minimize the impact.

In line with our ongoing commitment to access affordability and our efforts to assist students and their families, Post University will continue to assist students with demonstrated financial need in the 2023-24 academic year. Current students who maintain eligibility, including continuous enrollment, will receive the same dollar amount, under the same terms of their present academic merit, athletic, and other university scholarships each semester through to graduation. Federal student aid, including work-study funding, and external scholarships will continue to be available for those who qualify. Students should contact their financial aid advisor to learn more about financial aid opportunities.
