After completing this non-degree seeking enrollment, students must apply for the RN to Bachelor of Science Nursing program *after completing an associate of science nursing or diploma nursing program and passing the NCLEX-RN® Exam.*

(Students who fail to meet the associate degree or diploma and NCLEX requirements are not eligible to continue into the RN to Bachelor of Science Nursing program.)
