ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

All students must have an active, unencumbered registered nursing license and a bachelor's degree in nursing with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Requires a minimum of one year of full-time work experience in a nursing clinical role in the last three years.

LICENSURE

We offer the MSN degree with Nurse Practitioner specializations to residents of most states in the U.S. We do not offer the specializations to residents of Arizona, District of Columbia, Louisiana, New York, Oregon, Tennessee, or Washington.
