## ITEMS TO BRING

This list is non-exhaustive and each student should consider their individual needs and preferences when packing.

### Residence Hall & Personal Essentials

- Twin XL sized bedding (sheets, pillowcases, comforter/blanket, mattress protector)
- Pillows
- Towels and washcloths
- Laundry basket or bag
- Clothes hangers
- Storage bins or organizers
- Cleaning supplies
- Mini fridge + Microwave (No bigger than 3.0 cubic ft. and 1 amp. power)
- Toiletries/Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, deodorant, razor, etc.)
- Shower caddy
- Flip flops/shower shoes
- Clothes appropriate for all seasons
- Comfortable shoes

### Academic & Technology Supplies

- Backpack or day bag
- Laptop/Tablet and charger
- Phone and charger
- Headphones or earbuds
- Notebooks, binders, folders
- Pens, pencils, highlighters
- Planner or calendar
- Textbooks and course materials

### Important Information

- Identification (driver's license, student ID, insurance cards)
- Important documents (financial aid info., health records)

## PLEASE DO NOT BRING

- Full Sized Refrigerators  
Air Conditioners
- Hot Plates/Hot Pots/Open Coil  
Burners
- Stoves or fryers (unless used in the  
designated kitchen area)
- Any appliance not UL-Labeled
- Space Heaters
- Immersion Heaters
- Extension cords or outlet strips  
(unless surge protected, grounded,  
or insulated)
- Toasters/Toaster-oven broilers  
(unless used in designed kitchen  
area)
- Dart Boards
- Lofts
- Water beds and “kiddie” pools
- Torchiere lamps with non-  
fluorescent bulbs
- Any items hanging from the ceiling,  
fire equipment, or sprinklers
- Candles, with or without wick
- Multiple outlets plugs (unless surge  
protected, grounded, or insulated)
- Incense, either burned or unused
- Stored Flammables (e.g. gasoline,  
lighter fluid, charcoal, propane  
tanks, etc.)
- Hoverboards
- Motorized bikes or other  
combustible engines
- Live holiday trees or wreaths
- Dangerous and flammable room  
decorations
- Weapons (please see the “Firearms,  
Ammunitions, Knives, Hazardous  
Chemicals, and Other Dangerous  
Weapons section on page 22 for  
more information)
- Weapon replicas or items that look  
like weapons (Orbeez guns, Airsoft  
guns, etc.)
