## ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

All students must have an active, unencumbered registered nursing license and a bachelor's degree in nursing with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

## REQUIRED COURSES

All MSN students will complete the courses below, followed by the six courses required in their specialization:

- > Theoretical Foundations
- > Research Design
- > Policy Advocacy & Healthcare Ethics
- > Integrated Advanced Pathopharmacology
- > Advanced Health Assessment

## TWO WAYS TO LEARN

### Term Based:

- > Structured 8-week terms
- > Complete 1-2 courses per term
- > Consistent due dates
- > Regular peer interaction through discussion posts
- > Competency mainly demonstrated through writing papers
- > Fewer assignments utilizing digital resources
- > Tuition: **\$16,128\***  
Resource Fee: \$50 per course  
Graduation Fee: \$150

### SIMPath® (Competency Based):

- > Self-paced 16-week semesters
- > Start with two classes. Add in more as your schedule allows
- > You can register for additional classes up to the 13th week
- > Unfinished courses will need to be repeated
- > No specified due dates until the end of the semester
- > Meet weekly with your instructor to stay on track
- > Competency demonstrated in unique ways such as PowerPoint presentations, graphics, videos, papers, or something completely new
- > Use digital resources to enhance learning experience
- > Tuition: **\$12,800\* (4 semesters)**  
Resource Fee: \$200 per semester  
Graduation Fee: \$150
